







<p>#1 Carry out some research into an NHS career, e.g. paramedic, doctor, nurse, dentist etc. and present your research either in your homework books or on Google docs/slides.</p> 	<p>#2 Visit Cwmbran library, find a book related to the human body or NHS careers. Read it and write a book review to say what it was about and what you have learned.</p> 	<p>#3 Design a poster about something you need to do to stay healthy, e.g. a poster about why/how you need to look after your teeth, eat healthily or avoid smoking.</p> 
<p>#4 How many different ways can you make the number 70? You can use addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. (There are literally millions of ways!)</p> 	<p>#5 Create your own artwork using only the elements line and shape.</p> 	<p>#6 How many different words can you make out of 'OPERATION OUCH'? e.g. open, rat, note, tin etc.</p> 
<p>#7 Create your own marvellous medicine like George in "George's Marvellous Medicine" <u>using safe ingredients only</u>. Then, write instructions on how you made it! You could even take a photo or bring it into school and share it with the class!</p> 	<p>#8 How many different numbers can you make using the digits - 1948? e.g. 19, 48, 194, 1984 There are many, many different numbers & combinations. Can you work systematically?</p> 	<p>#9 Practise writing (at least ten) sentences containing <u>there</u>, <u>their</u> or <u>they're</u>.</p>
